



Donation, Contribution & Giving Overview

The *Siberian Husky Club & Rescue of Southern New England's* rescue program covers the States of Connecticut and Rhode Island. Because of the benevolence of caring individuals like yourself, displaced Siberians avoid being left to roam to either meet an untimely and lonely death on a busy or back street, or by lethal injunction in an overcrowded animal shelter.

The club's rescue program includes microchipping all the Siberians that we rescue. Home Again Retrieval Systems, a division of Schering-Plough Animal Health, provides the microchips and scanners to read the chips at minimal cost. Idexx Laboratories, through their "Shelter Program", supplies in-clinic testing kits so that all our Siberians can receive a complete "Wellness Check" when they are brought into the rescue program. Every Siberian in the program is brought current on all needed and required vaccinations, and any medical considerations are resolved so our Siberians are assured of a healthy and good quality of life. All Siberians in the rescue program are spayed or neutered unless there are overriding medical considerations. Under no circumstances are any Siberians allowed to be used for breeding purposes.

Our club is recognized for educational, charitable, and other activities that qualify for exemption under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code. The IRS has designated us as a "public charity" under said code. All contributions to the club; including bequests, devises, transfers or gifts, qualify as being tax deductible under sections 2055, 2106 or 2522 of said Code. No part of the net earnings of the club inure to the benefit of, or are distributed to; the club's members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the club is authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered, and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the club's purposes. No substantial part of the activities of the club involves the carrying on of propaganda to influence legislation, and the club does not participate in, or intervene (including the publishing or distribution of statements) in any political campaign on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office. The club does not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by; a club exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code; or a club, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code. If the club should legally dissolve, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be transferred to a nonprofit Siberian Husky club or organization dedicated to the same purposes for which this club was organized and operated for.
